

Zoom rules & FAQs

Zoom is very easy to use – we’ve uploaded some easy user guides to the Facebook group file section.

Security – most of the initial security issue reported in the news around Zoom were using the free version, many of which have been addressed by the company ; we have a paid licensed version so security is even better. That being said, please don’t share the meeting password with anyone, share the registration link instead; that way we can further ensure security.

Cost? – Joining one of our Zoom meetings is free for you.

Do I have to be on camera? - Only if you want to, you can join any meeting with your audio only if you wish. You can, if you wish change the background if you do chose to be on camera (so no need to tidy up 😊) For details on how to do that click [HERE](#)

And now onto some very basic rules for when in a Zoom meeting

Basic Zoom Room Rules!

- You must pre-register to join the meeting.
- Don’t share meeting password that is emailed to you, share the registration link (for security)
- Be kind and respectful to all participants, at all times.
- No hate speech of any kind.
- No bullying.
- Please give everyone the chance to speak if they wish to.
- Respect people’s privacy; don’t take screenshots or recordings, or share other people’s conversations outside of the meeting.

- Try and find a quiet space for you to sit (ha ha ha what is a quiet space I hear you ask!)
- The only silly question is the one that isn’t asked!
